- 2. Must complete the bundle requirements to earn the cash incentive**
- 3. Must have CFFCU Business membership with operational checking account**
- 4. Either home or business address must fall within a Covid distressed area (ERP Zone by CDFI Fund)**
- 5. No non-profits**
